As the exclusive provider of Plainfield Community Consolidated School District 202's onsite before and after school program, the C.W. Avery Family YMCA has the distinct pleasure of working each day with the youth in Plainfield. As District 202 prepares to transition to a hybrid learning model, we are continuing to monitor updates from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and local, state and federal health officials to ensure our YMCA is prepared to welcome students to our Kid Zone PLUS program.

As our community continues to navigate through this public health crisis, the Y is committed to providing much-needed child care for District 202 families during the 2020-2021 school year. The C.W. Avery Family YMCA will be providing child care, with remote learning support, for kids in grades K-8 at one centralized location in downtown Plainfield:

#### Drop-Off/Pick-Up Location:

When heading south on Illinois Street in downtown Plainfield, please make a right onto Chicago Street. On the north side of Chicago Street, you will find 3 designated Kid Zone PLUS parking spots. After parking in one of the spots, please call or text the site phone (779-702-8806) and remain in your vehicle, while wearing a mask or face covering. A member of our Kid Zone PLUS team will come outside to assist you.

Overflow parking for drop off and pick up will also be available in the PUMC parking lot, located on the southwest corner of Chicago and Illinois Streets. After parking in one of the overflow parking spots, which will be marked clearly with Kid Zone PLUS signs, please call or text the site phone, remain in your vehicle, and wait for a member of our Kid Zone PLUS team to assist you.

### KID ZONE PLUS PROGRAM CURRICULUM

The YMCA's character building campaign pledges to incorporate the values of Caring, Honesty, Respect and Responsibility into all of its youth programming. Our Kid Zone PLUS program will provide a resource-rich environment for children of all ages. Students will participate in activities throughout the day that focus on arts and humanities, character development, wellness, fitness, and literacy. Significant time each day will also be dedicated to students' remote learning activities. However, please know that all remote learning assignments may not be completed during program hours.

## HEALTH AND SAFETY GUIDELINES

Because the safety of our community remains our top priority, we have made modifications to our policies and programs to facilitate new safety and social distancing guidelines. To maintain a healthy and safe environment, all Kid Zone PLUS participants and staff will be required to adhere to strict health and safety guidelines, including:

- Daily health screenings and temperature checks
- Mask requirements
- Frequent handwashing

Students will be divided into small groups by grade level to ensure social distancing can be maintained throughout the day. Each group will have its own designated spaces and equipment.

The Y will also ensure high-touch areas are sanitized hourly.

## PROGRAM HOURS AND FEES

Option #1:

### KID ZONE PLUS – FULL-TIME CARE

Designed for students participating in 5 days of remote learning

- Students attend Kid Zone PLUS Monday–Friday from 7 a.m.–6 p.m.

Facility Members: \$195 per week

Community Members: \$220 per week

Option #2:

### KID ZONE PLUS– 3 REMOTE LEARNING DAYS

Designed for students participating in hybrid learning

- Students attend Kid Zone PLUS from 7 a.m.–6 p.m. on the days they are scheduled to participate in remote learning activities.

Facility Members: \$117 per week

Community Members: \$132 per week

Option #3:

### KID ZONE PLUS– 3 REMOTE LEARNING DAYS AND AFTER SCHOOL CARE ON IN-PERSON SCHOOL DAYS

Designed for students participating in hybrid learning

- Students attend Kid Zone PLUS from 7 a.m.–6 p.m. on the days they are scheduled to participate in remote learning activities. Students also attend the Y's after school program at the Plainfield United Methodist Church (PUMC) on the days they attend school in-person. The YMCA is unable to transport students at this time. Transportation would need to be arranged by the parent or guardian.

Facility Members: \$156 per week

Community Members: \$176 per week
