KID ZONE PLUS PROGRAM CURRICULUM

The YMCA's character building campaign pledges to incorporate the values of Caring, Honesty, Respect and Responsibility into all of its youth programming. Our Kid Zone PLUS program will provide a resource-rich environment for children in grades K-8. Students will participate in activities throughout the day that focus on arts and humanities, character development, wellness, fitness, and literacy. HEALTH AND SAFETY GUIDELINES

Because the safety of our community remains our top priority, we have made modifications to our policies and programs to facilitate new safety and social distancing guidelines. To maintain a healthy and safe environment, all Kid Zone PLUS participants and staff will be required to adhere to strict health and safety guidelines, including:

- Daily health screenings and temperature checks
- Mask requirements
- Frequent handwashing
- Students will be divided into small groups to ensure social distancing can be maintained throughout the day. Each group will have its own designated spaces and equipment.
- High-touch areas will be sanitized hourly.


PROGRAM FEES
