## Kid Zone PLUS Youth Enrichment Program



Serving Troy CCSD 30C Families

As a longtime provider of before and after school care for families in Troy CCSD 30C, the Galowich Family YMCA has the distinct pleasure of working each day with the youth in our community. We continue to monitor updates from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and local, state and federal health officials to ensure our YMCA is prepared to welcome students to our Kid Zone PLUS program.

### ALWAYS HERE FOR OUR COMMUNITY

As our community continues to navigate through this public health crisis, the Y is committed to providing much-needed child care for families like yours during the 2020-2021 school year. The Y will be teaming up with Troy CCSD 30C to provide child care, with e-learning support, for children in Grades K-8.

Troy CCSD 30C will transport students from the following schools to the Galowich Family YMCA



Heritage Trail Elementary School



William B. Orenic Intermediate School



Troy Middle School

Transportation through the school district is limited.

Students enrolling in the Y's after school Kid Zone PLUS program from Craughwell, Cronin, Hofer and Shorewood Elementary Schools will need to provide their own transportation to the YMCA.

### KID ZONE PLUS PROGRAM CURRICULUM

The YMCA's character building campaign pledges to incorporate the values of Caring, Honesty, Respect and Responsibility into all of its youth programming. Our Kid Zone PLUS program will provide a resource-rich environment for children in grades K-8. Students will participate in activities throughout the day that focus on arts and humanities, character development, wellness, fitness, and literacy. Significant time each day will also be dedicated to students' remote learning activities.

### HEALTH AND SAFETY GUIDELINES

Because the safety of our community remains our top priority, we have made modifications to our policies and programs to facilitate new safety and social distancing guidelines. To maintain a healthy and safe environment, all Kid Zone PLUS participants and staff will be required to adhere to strict health and safety guidelines, including:

- Daily health screenings and temperature checks
- Mask requirements
- Frequent handwashing
- High-touch areas will be sanitized hourly.
- Students will be divided into small groups to ensure social distancing can be maintained throughout the day. Each group will have its own designated spaces and equipment.

### KID ZONE PLUS- BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL CARE\*

Designed for students participating in hybrid learning 5 days a week

- Students attend Kid Zone PLUS from 7 a.m. until school starts. After attending school in-person, students return to Kid Zone PLUS until 6 p.m. The YMCA is unable to transport students at this time. Transportation would need to be arranged by the parent or through the school district.

Facility Members: \$96 per week

Community Members: \$108 per week

### KID ZONE PLUS- AFTER SCHOOL CARE ONLY

Designed for students participating in hybrid learning 5 days a week

- Students attend Kid Zone PLUS after school - 6 p.m. on the days they attend school in-person. The YMCA is unable to transport students at this time. Transportation would need to be arranged by the parent or through the school district.

Facility Members: \$85 per week

Community Members: \$96 per week

Students will receive lunch, one healthy snack and a cold supper each day.
