- In fall 2014, the Morris Community YMCA and Morris Hospital & Healthcare Centers announced the formation of a partnership to enhance the health and wellness of Grundy County residents. Under this multi-year plan, the YMCA and Morris Hospital worked together to open the new temporary Morris Community YMCA location in downtown Morris in January 2015.
- During the first six months of 2015, the Morris Community YMCA provided more than \$9,000 in financial assistance to families in need from throughout Morris and Grundy County.
- During the school year, the Morris Community YMCA partners with White Oak Elementary School to provide a safe and affordable before and after school program for elementary school students.
- In 2015, a record 840 children participated in summer day camps, sports camps and specialty camps at the Morris Community YMCA.
- Nearly 500 area youth learned the importance of teamwork by participating in the YMCA's youth basketball leagues in Morris and Coal City.
- Nearly 100 adults participated in the Morris Community YMCA's first-ever adult soccer league.
