In order to apply to participate in the Counselor in Training Program, prospective participants must:

- Be a registered summer day camper in grades 7-8 (Fall 2025). Regular camp fees apply.
- Submit a CIT application
- Submit two letters of recommendation from a mentor (teacher, coach, pastor, etc.)
- Participate in an interview with our Youth and Family team

Once applications and references have been reviewed, interviews will be scheduled. Space is limited and, unfortunately, not all applicants will be accepted.

Applications and accompanying materials must be submitted by Saturday, May 18.
